Code of Conduct for Student

The college finds it necessary to adopt a unique and value based codes for the overall development of the student personality. All the students enrolled in the college shall abide by the rules laid down for the smooth functioning of the college machinery.

1. Students are expected to maintain discipline and dignified manner of behavior inside as well as outside of the college campus.
2. Students shall abide by the rules and regulations of the college and should act in a way that highlights the discipline and decorum of the college.
3. A six day working schedule from Monday to Saturday is followed and classes and labs are scheduled from 9.00 to 4.00 pm.
4. The college begins with the state and National anthem to promote a sense of patriotism in students.
5. A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory for every student to appear for the semester examinations.
6. All the students expected to be present in the class in time. Late coming will result in loss of attendance for the corresponding hour.
7. The gates will closed so that no student shall leave the campus before the stipulated time.
8. All the students should attend the college in uniform and shall wear their student ID cards.
9. Political activity of any form is not entertained within the college campus.
10. Students are not permitted to use mobile phones within the college campus.
11. Consumption of intoxicants in any form is strictly prohibited.



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Code of Conduct for Teachers

The college envisages that faculty members shall be the role model for the students to follow. He/She is expected to be a mentor, facilitator and guide to the students.

- Every teacher shall by percept and example shall mould the minds of the students entrusted to his/her care to be a responsible citizen of this country.
- Every teacher shall train and tame the minds of the students to inculcate respect for law and order.
- Every teacher shall sensitize the students about unhealthy and bad customs and practices in the society and strive his/her best to be critical about it.
- Every teacher shall cooperate with and secure the coopeartion of other persons in all activities which aim at the improvement of the moral , mental and physical well beings of pupils.
- Every teacher shall be strictly impartial in his relations with all his pupils. He shall be sympathetic and helpfull, particularly to the slow learners.
- Every teacher shall be temperate and sober in his habits. He shall scrupulously avoid undesirable habits in the presence of students and within the precincts of the college.
- Every teacher shall have an exemplary moral charcter. His dealing with the members of the opposite sex in the college or outside shall not be such as would cause reflection on his/her character or bring discredit to the college.
- No teacher shall indulge in or encourage any form of malpractice connected with examinations or other college activities.
- Confidential matters relating to the institutions and the department shall not be divulged by any teacher.



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- No teacher shall undertake private tuition or private employment or otherwise engage himself in any business.
 - Every teacher shall be clean and trim. He shall not be casual and informal, while on duty. His dress shall be neat and dignified. He shall on no account be dressed so as to become an object of excitement or ridicule or pity at the hands of students and colleagues.
 - Every teacher shall be punctual in attendance in respect of his class work as also for any other work connected with the duties assigned to him by the principal. He shall realize that he is a member of the team and shall help in developing a corporate life in the school.
 - Every teacher shall abide by the rules and regulations of the college and show due respect to the constituted authority, diligently carrying out instructions issued to him by the superior authority.
 - No teacher shall apply for an assignment or job outside the college directly. He shall invariably forward his applications through proper channel.
 - No teacher shall present his grievances, if any, except through proper channel, nor will he be a canvas for any non official or outside influences or support in the respect of any matter pertaining to his service in the college.
 - No teacher shall accept or permit any member of his family or any other person acting on his behalf to accept any gift from any pupil, parent or any person with whom he has come into contact by virtue of his position in the college except as provided under rule 13 of the CCS(Conduct) Rules, 1964.
